




HOUSTON AND ITS UNDERLYING GOVERNMENT ENTITIES

Fast Facts

- The City of Houston has a Taxpayer Burden of \$11,600, which is each taxpayer's share of the city's debt.
- Houston taxpayers also pay taxes to the county and other underlying government units. If these debts are included, each taxpayer's burden is \$13,100.
- When state debt is added, each taxpayer has a burden of \$24,400.
