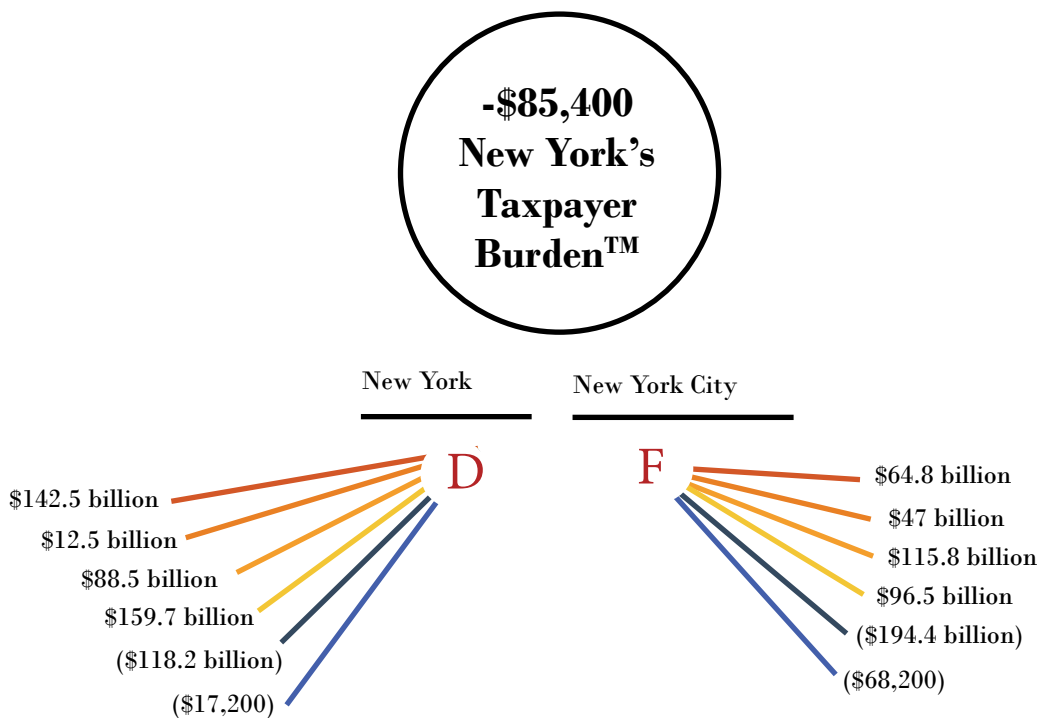

Fast Facts

- New York City has a Taxpayer Burden of \$68,200, which is each taxpayer's share of the city's debt.
- Unlike other cities, New York City's underlying government units are already included in the city's annual financial report.
- When state debt is added to city debt, each taxpayer has a burden of \$85,400
