FAST FACTS

- San Diego has a Taxpayer Burden of \$5,400, which is each taxpayer's share of the city's debt.
- San Diego taxpayers also pay taxes to the county and other underlying government units. If these debts are included, each taxpayer's burden is \$13,720.
- When state debt is added to city debt, each taxpayer has a burden of \$35,320.
