FAST FACTS

- San Antonio has a Taxpayer Burden of \$3,000, which is each taxpayer's share of the city's debt.
- San Antonio taxpayers also pay taxes to the county and other underlying government units. If these debts are included, each taxpayer's burden is \$6,265.
- When state debt is added to city debt, each taxpayer has a burden of \$14,865.
